# Foundational Alignment (Review)

- Week 1 – Ownership: God owns it all. Psalm 24:1 (KJV), “The earth is the LORD’S, and the fulness thereof; the world, and they that dwell therein.”
- Week 2 – Alignment: Faith must match behavior. Matthew 6:33 (KJV), “But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.”

# Foundational Alignment (Review)

- Week 3 – Atmosphere: Words and habits sustain change. 3 John 1:2 (KJV), “Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in good health, even as thy soul prospereth.”

If the soul changes but speech and habits do not, progress and prosperity will stall.

# The Power of Words – Proverbs 18:21 (KJV)

---

- Proverbs 18:21, “Death and life are in the power of the tongue: and they that love it shall eat the fruit thereof.”
- Your mouth determines what kind of harvest your finances experience!

# Words Shape Financial Atmosphere

---

- Matthew 12:37 (KJV); “For by thy words thou shalt be justified, and by thy words thou shalt be condemned.”

# Speaking What God Says

---

- Romans 4:17 (KJV),“(As it is written, I have made these a father of many nations,) before him whom he believed, even God, who quickeneth the dead, and calleth those things which be not as though they were.”

# The Tongue Directs Life

---

James 3:5-6 (KJV); "5 "Even so the tongue is a little member, and boasteth great things. Behold, how great a matter a little fire kindleth!"6 "And the tongue is a fire, a world of iniquity: so is the tongue among our members, that it defileth the whole body, and setteth on fire the course of nature; and it is set on fire of hell."

## Alignment Is Essential

- Week 2 taught us that:  
*Faith must show up in behavior*
- Week 3 adds: *Behavior starts with speech*

You cannot speak lack all week and pray abundance on Sunday.

## The Thermometer vs. Thermostat

- Thermometer reports the temperature
- Thermostat sets the temperature

Many believers *report* debt, stress, and fear instead of regulating their financial atmosphere with faith-filled words.

# Speaking to Dead Places

---

- Ezekiel 37:3–5 (KJV); “<sup>3</sup> And he said unto me, Son of man, can these bones live? And I answered, O Lord GOD, thou knowest. <sup>4</sup> Again he said unto me, Prophecy upon these bones, and say unto them, O ye dry bones, hear the word of the LORD. <sup>5</sup> Thus saith the Lord GOD unto these bones; Behold, I will cause breath to enter into you, and ye shall live:”

# Movement Before Completion

---

- Ezekiel 37:7 (KJV); “<sup>7</sup> So I prophesied as I was commanded: and as I prophesied, there was a noise, and behold a shaking, and the bones came together, bone to his bone.”
- God did not speak for Ezekial—He told Ezekial to speak. God often waits for your obedience and your voice before He releases provision.

# **Structure Before Breath**

- God restores order before overflow.
- Bones before breath.
- Budget before blessing.
- Discipline before increase.

# Decreeing God's Order

- Job 22:28 (KJV), “Thou shalt also decree a thing, and it shall be established unto thee.”

# **God's Word Always Works**

- Isaiah 55:11 (KJV), “So shall my word be... it shall not return unto me void.”

# Financial Application

- Noise does not equal Completion
- Movement does not equal Overflow
- God restores structure before supply
  - Budget before blessing
  - Discipline before increase
  - Order before overflow

# **Words Frame Reality**

- Hebrews 11:3 (KJV), “The worlds were framed by the word of God.”

# Faith That Speaks

---

- Mark 11:23 (KJV), “<sup>23</sup> For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith.
- Faith is not silent—and it is not lazy!

# Faith Must Act

- James 2:17 (KJV), “Faith, if it hath not works, is dead.”

# **Stewardship Requires Consistency**

- Luke 16:10 (KJV), “He that is faithful in that which is least is faithful also in much.”
- Stewards must act responsibly with what they confess.

# The Ant Principle

- Proverbs 6:6–8 (KJV), “<sup>6</sup> Go to the ant, thou sluggard; consider her ways, and be wise: <sup>7</sup> Which having no guide, overseer, or ruler, <sup>8</sup> Provideth her meat in the summer, and gathereth her food in the harvest.”
- The ant prepares before the pressure shows up.

# **Diligence Creates Momentum**

- Proverbs 21:5 (KJV), “The thoughts of the diligent tend only to plenteousness.”

# Don't Quit the Process

- Galatians 6:9 (KJV), “In due season we shall reap, if we faint not.”

## **Momentum vs. Miracles**

- A Miracle rescues you once
- Momentum sustains you long-term

God honors consistent obedience more than occasional excitement.
