The Foundational Law of Sowing and Reaping Galatians 6:7–9 (KJV)

6 Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap. 7 For he that soweth to his flesh shall of the flesh reap corruption; but he that soweth to the Spirit shall of the Spirit reap life everlasting. 8 And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not.

**The Foundational Law
of Sowing and
Reaping---Galatians
6:7–9 (KJV)**

Sowing is optional---reaping is not.

Seed determines harvest.

Time separates planting from payoff.

**Wisdom Outcome---Why slow change is
real change.**

God builds freedom the same way He
builds crops---over time.

Quick relief excites you.

Slow systems transform you.

Genesis 8:22 (KJV)

Gen. 8:22; “While the earth remaineth, seedtime and harvest, and cold and heat, and summer and winter, and day and night shall not cease.”

- God tied provision to process, not panic.
- Why systems beat excitement:
 - Seedtime and harvest is a system, not a surprise.
 - Budgeting is a system.
 - Saving is a system.
 - Giving is a system.

The Pattern of the Sower Matthew 13:3–9 (KJV)

Matthew 13:3-9 RSV:

3 And he told them many things in parables, saying: "A sower went out to sow. 4 And as he sowed, some seeds fell along the path, and the birds came and devoured them. 5 Other seeds fell on rocky ground, where they had not much soil, and immediately they sprang up, since they had no depth of soil,

The Pattern of the Sower

Matthew 13:3–9

(KJV)

6 but when the sun rose they were scorched; and since they had no root they withered away. 7 Other seeds fell upon thorns, and the thorns grew up and choked them. 8 Other seeds fell on good soil and brought forth grain, some a hundredfold, some sixty, some thirty. 9 He who has ears, let him hear."

Teaching:

The seed was the same.

The soil made the difference.

**Wisdom Outcome-Why systems beat
excitement:**

Good soil=good habits.

Good habits=predictable harvest.

Excitement plants nothing.

Discipline plants daily.

Teaching:

Fast money fades.

Slow systems last.

**Wisdom Outcome-Why slow change
is real change:**

God prefers process over prizes.

Lottery money shocks the system.

Legacy money strengthens it.

**Obedience Activates
Harvest Deuteronomy
28:1–8 (KJV)**

28 “And if you faithfully obey the voice of the LORD your God, being careful to do all his commandments that I command you today, the LORD your God will set you high above all the nations of the earth. ² And all these blessings shall come upon you and overtake you, if you obey the voice of the LORD your God. ³ Blessed shall you be in the city, and blessed shall you be in the field. ⁴ Blessed shall be the fruit of your womb and the fruit of your ground and the fruit of your cattle, the increase of your herds and the young of your flock.

**Obedience Activates
Harvest Deuteronomy
28:1–8 (KJV)**

⁵ Blessed shall be your basket and your kneading bowl. ⁶ Blessed shall you be when you come in, and blessed shall you be when you go out.

⁷ “The LORD will cause your enemies who rise against you to be defeated before you. They shall come out against you one way and flee before you seven ways. ⁸ The LORD will command the blessing on you in your barns and in all that you undertake. And he will bless you in the land that the LORD your God is giving you.

**Obedience Activates
Harvest Deuteronomy
28:1–8 (KJV)**

**Wisdom Outcome-Why
obedience beats luck:**

Luck is random.

Obedience is repeatable.

God does not bless chances—
He blesses choices.

Giving as a Spiritual Seed

Malachi 3:10 (KJV)

Malachi 3:10, Bring ye all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be meat in mine house, and prove me now herewith, saith the LORD of hosts, if I will not open you the windows of heaven, and pour you out a blessing, that there shall not be room enough to receive it.

Malachi 3:10 (KJV)**

Teaching:

God ties provision to trust.

**Wisdom Outcome-Why God
honors seed:**

God multiplies what is planted,
not what is spent.

Giving as a Spiritual Seed

Luke 6:38 (KJV)

Luke 6:38, "Give, and it shall be given unto you; good measure, pressed down, and shaken together, and running over, shall men give into your bosom. For with the same measure that ye mete withal it shall be measured to you again."




**Faith Without

James 1:22, But be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves.


Wisdom Outcome---Why systems beat excitement:
