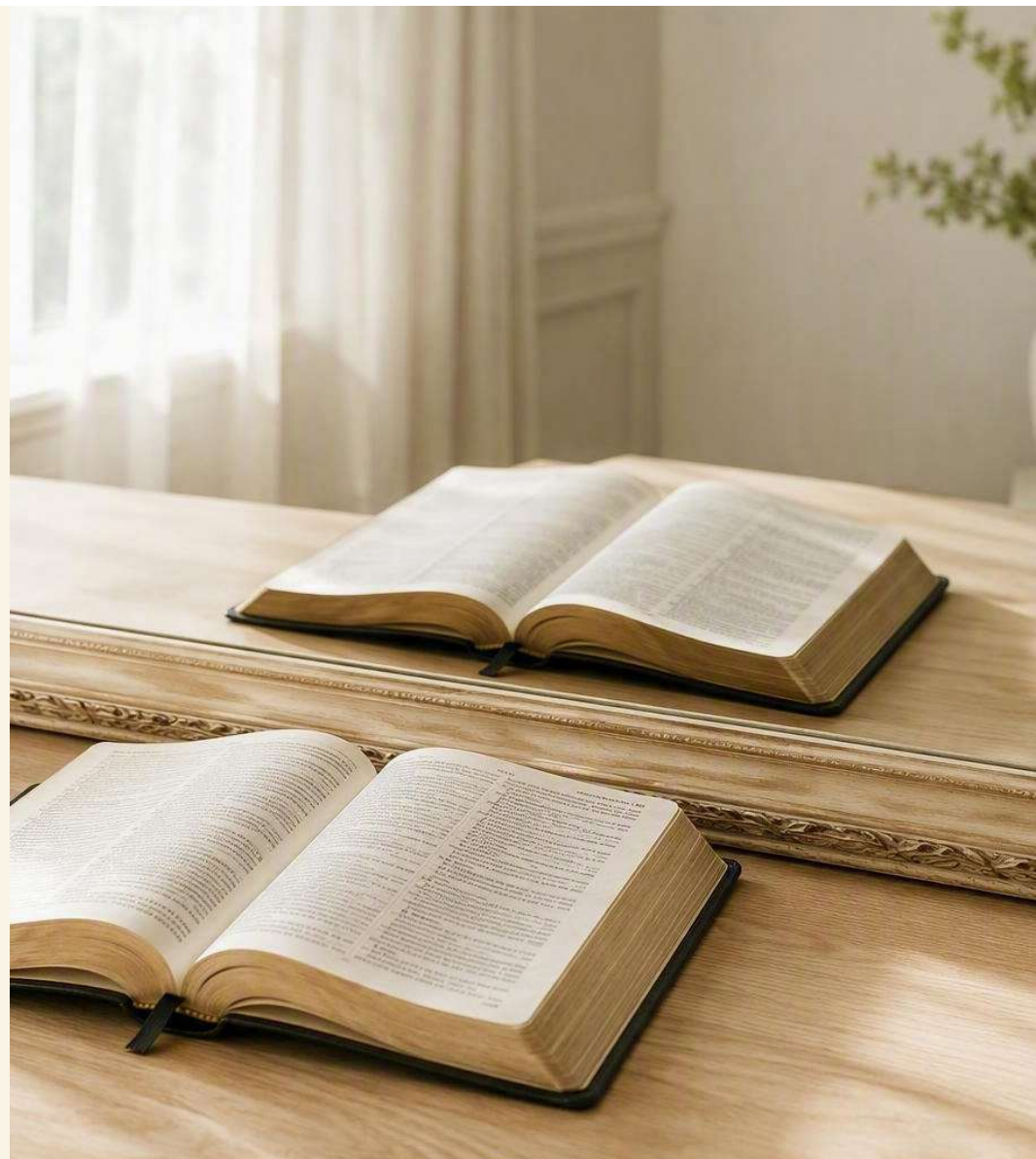
The Mirror Warning

We Must Share It.

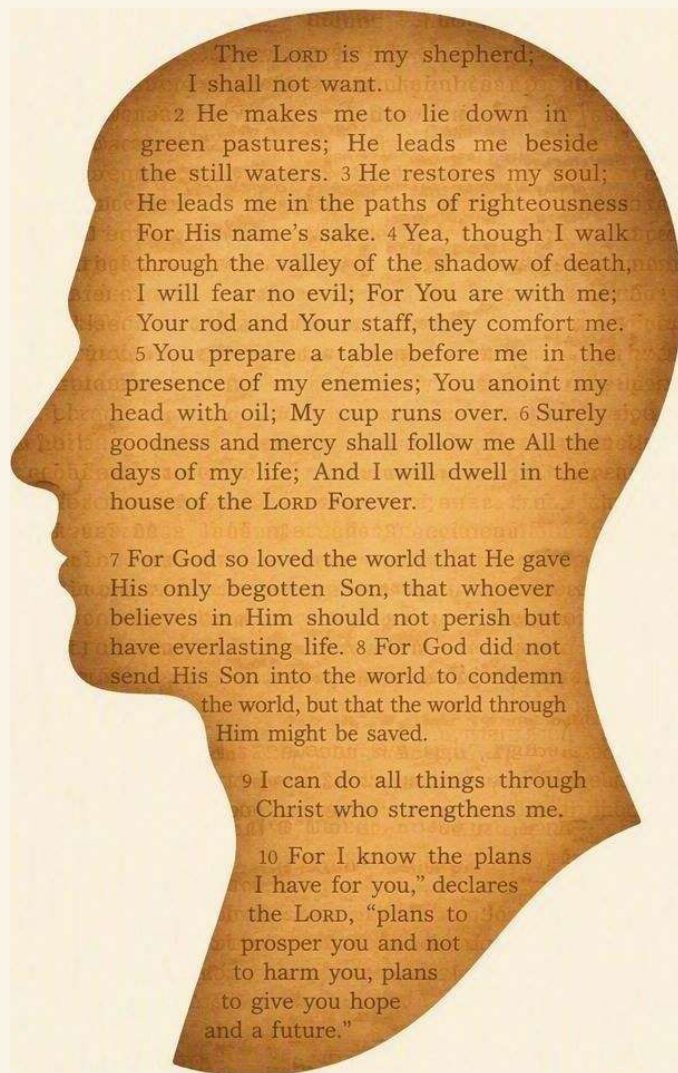
“How then will they call on him in whom they have not believed?”

Scripture does not simply add facts to our thinking; it re-forms how we think.

Identity, money, justice, family — every assumption comes under its authority.

When Scripture and Culture Conflict

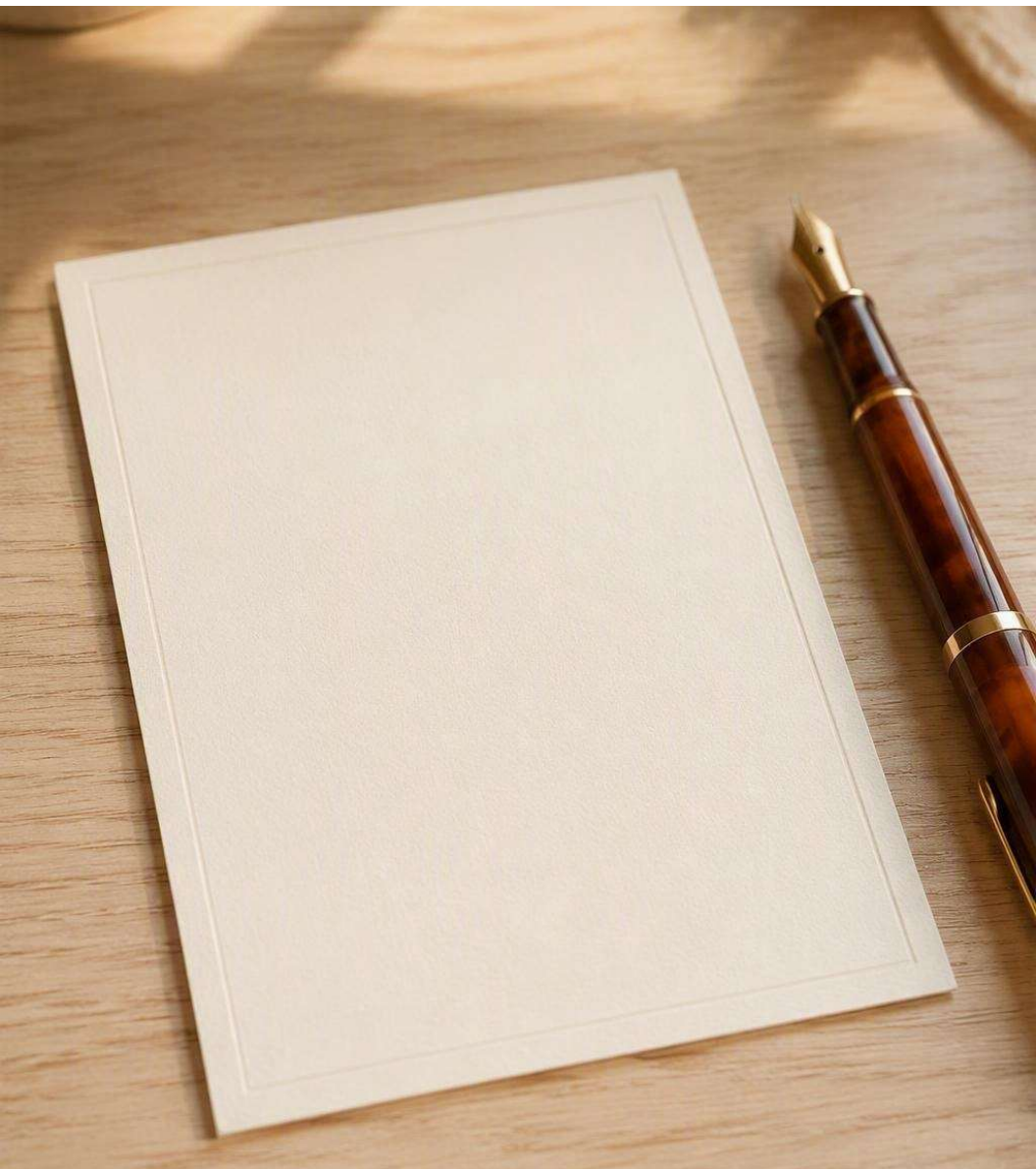
"We must obey God rather than men."
